Note:

- 1. While travel period is allowed between July 25 through to Aug. 14, 2012, the travel window remains within one week, i.e. if outbound flight e.g. Edmonton-Vancouver is on July 31 (Sun), the return trip (Vancouver-Edmonton) must be completed by Aug. 7, 2012 (the next Sunday), etc.
- 2. To qualify for Conventions special fare, GR2012 will need a minimum of 10 delegates travelling from various origins to the same destination with Air Canada's extensive North American and International network.
