



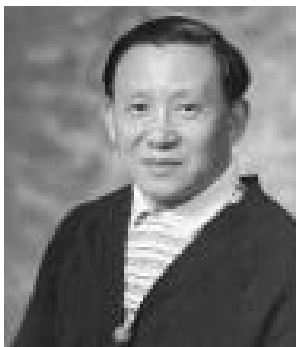

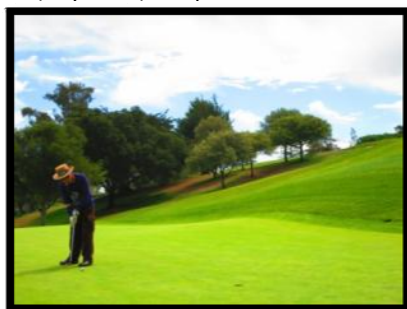

International Mathematics Olympiad

The 54th International Mathematics Olympiad (IMO) was held in Santa Marta, Colombia, from the 18th to the 28th July. There were 527 competitors from 97 countries. The Hong Kong Team was ranked 31 out of the 97 teams. In the individual section the six Hong Kong Team members captured 1 Silver medal and 5 Bronze medals in total. HUI Pak Nam Jeffrey (6F) and WONG Hing Shing Benjamin (6G) both captured a Bronze medal.

Squash Achievements – Asian Youth Games 2013 and the Hong Kong Squash Junior Open 2013

LING To Yu Andes (5B) won the (BU17) Hong Kong Squash Junior Open Title after three tough pool rounds prior to the quarter final.

LO Chris (6A) came 5th in the Individual Event and was a member of the Hong Kong Team that came 3rd (Bronze Medal winners) in the Team's event at the Asian Youth Games in Nanjing from the 14th-24th August 2013. India and Malaysia came ahead of Hong Kong in both the Individual and Team events.

Bulgaria International Mathematics Competition 2013 & 15th Invitational World Youth Mathematics Intercity Competition

This competition was held in Bulgaria from 1-6 July 2013. YU Hoi Wai Harry (3C), won the Gold Medal in the individual competition and was also the only secondary school participant to receive a perfect score worldwide. The Hong Kong team came second overall with Japan securing the Championship.
