It is with great sadness *[that]* I announce the demise of a former teacher, Mr. Lawrence Chan (Hok Man) fondly *[known]* as LC. He graduated from HKU with an MA in Chinese. He joined the staff in '65 and left to head a Catholic Diocese school Bishop Valorta School at Tai Po. Under Mr. Chan's leadership it steadily evolved to become an "elite" school of Taipo. After his retirement he took over the helm of a special education needs school (for the academically elites of F6 &7) of the Tung Wah Group. His formal retirement did not alienate *[him]* from the LSC community, and *[he attended]* OB's functions whenever he could. *[Mr. Chan]* came from one of the top public secondary schools. His two younger brothers attended LSC.

Brothers, light a candle in your hearts for Mr. Lawrence Chan. He was a good teacher and educator.
