## A Recap of the 2018 LSCOBA Global Reunion

### New York / East Coast Chapter

At the 2016 Global Reunion in Toronto, the New York/East Coast Chapter committed to host the 2018 Global Reunion. After 2 years of intensive planning, the event was kicked-off on August 1, 2018 at Miami Beach, Florida and was successfully completed on August 10, 2018. Upon conclusion of the reunion, some participants continued with a side trip in New Orleans.



This 2018 Global Reunion was indeed a unique, non-traditional event, not only did the event take place outside of the New York region of the host chapter, but it also included both land and sea adventures. The reunion program started with 2 days of warm-up activities in South Beach Miami where all Old Boys and their families enjoyed nightclub shows, a national park tour and a specialty steak dinner. ## 惡補爺爺作品 梁醒波孫變粵劇迷 帶波叔到 2018

**Editor's note:** 《我們的波叔》兩代喇沙仔的爸爸與爺爺。梁醒波乃首位獲 MBE 的華人演藝家，從文武生轉型丑生，跨越粵劇、電影與電視。任多屆八和會館主席，創辦八和小學及粵劇學院為香港人帶來教育機會。今年是波叔 110 歲誕辰，長孫梁智宏('95)，為爺爺做了回顧展，以現代的語言，來延續這位影響幾代華人成長的波叔的故事。

梁醒波與孫兒梁智宏 (Andrew) 之間，距離萬丈。你在天上，我在人間。Andrew 對爺爺最深印象，是三歲瞻仰遺容的一刻。你唱《鳳閣恩仇未了情》，我聽《Phantom of the Opera》。大戲與鬼佬大戲，東與西，在兩極。

這麼(親)近，又那麼(遙)遠。三十七歲時，他忽然「開竅」，密集「進補」爺爺作品，始發現粵劇不老土，粵語片不殘，可以好聽，好睇，好靚，好型。男人四十，四萬咁口高呼自己是個粵劇幼稚園生，跑到油麻地戲院看演出，就連神功戲也不錯過。「我覺得爺爺好似喺平行時空教緊我嘢，唔係佢，我唔會鑽研呢門文化。」波叔今年 110 歲冥壽，Andrew 出力協助重映電影及辦回顧展覽，希望比他年輕的一代，都能認識這位一代名伶。

### 與粵劇的半生緣

Andrew 是四份之三個番書仔，中五前在「喇沙」讀書，學鋼琴唱 choir。喜歡西洋音樂劇順理成章，覺得粵劇老土乃意料之內。「粵劇喺我成長嘅八、九十年代，不論演員定係觀眾都有斷層。大家都鍾意外國文化，英文歌、J pop，都會聽梅艷芳、張國榮，總之就唔會留意到粵曲。」那個年代，媚外是前衛，粵曲只能靠邊站。

赴英國讀大學，佔盡地利，不飽覽音樂劇？對不起自己！「放親假都特登坐火車落倫敦睇 musical，學生票咁平真係無理由唔睇。」喜歡粵劇的時辰未到，伶人一開口他總是聽到耳都側。「嗰陣唔明點解女人要吊高把聲唱大戲。」即使爺爺是紅透半邊天的大老倌，他心底一直把粵劇同「娘」劃上等號。有人說苦瓜是「半生瓜」，要有些年紀方懂品嚐箇中甘味。粵劇之於他，是「半生劇」，閱歷儲夠了，才懂梨園瑰寶之美。

### 興趣 mode 亮起

典型香港人故事：為攀事業高峰，忙到癲碌到傻，忽略重要的人，錯失緊要之事，到頭來反問自己：咁辛苦為乜？早年任職於知名珠寶品牌的 Andrew，管理大中華業務，出差頻頻，在空中多過陸上。「嗰幾年香港發生好多事，加上父母年紀開始大，我同公司講希望留港。」





我終於有時間睇番爺爺嘅演出。」一看，驚艷，再看，著迷，再三看，不得了。他說：「要嗒」，嗒動作，嗒戲服，嗒眼神，每項細節都出動金睛火眼。老倌在台上演繹開門，面前其實沒有一扇實際的門；入屋要提腿跨過隱形「門檻」，這些動作他覺得好看得很，不嗒不能。「又例如佢哋要騎馬，當然無馬，但佢哋手執馬鞭，加上動作，畀好多空間觀眾想像。」

我說這數年他的人生翻天覆地，他哈哈大笑謂：「係囉，三十七歲先來開竅。爺爺係粵劇 icon，無理由我身為佢個孫連睇都唔識睇。」他以「BB 班」知識觀看劇作，算是能心領神會，但說到透徹理解，他自問文學造詣及歷史知識還未到家。「有諗要唔要去學唱大戲，了解得深入啲，呢個下一步再算。」現階段他還是先勤力去看，不論規模大小。「之前我屋企附近有戲棚，做《六國大封相》。阮兆輝一出台好壓場，離遠睇會見到佢眼神都有交戲，好有氣勢。」認識曾與波叔合作的紅伶阮兆輝後，他得知更多爺爺往事，對粵劇興趣越燒越旺。

## 馬拉松式追看

港大教育學院中文教育研究中心於波叔百歲冥壽時出版《梁醒波傳——亦慈亦俠亦詼諧》一書，用文字 360 度重塑波叔的演藝人生，隨書附送的一張影碟，給 Andrew「煲到爛」。影碟收錄了波叔去世前不久與紅線女合演的《刁蠻公主戇駙馬》，是二人少有流傳下來的粵劇現場演出片段。兩個老朋友相隔 30 年沒見，同台合演實在難得。波叔沒當文武生良久，女姐也久沒演花旦，都使出渾身解數。「兩個都有段清唱，好好聽，我唔識形容，總之真係好聽，一啲都唔娘。」他慨歎無緣親眼欣賞。「如果我早五年出世，唔使多，就可以入場睇 live，會有印象好多。」

波叔叱咤粵劇界，從文武生轉型至丑生，演出劇目多不勝數。他後來轉攻大銀幕又拍下四百多部電影，追看波叔作品，絕對是浩瀚工程。他說來輕鬆：「有心唔怕遲嘅。」今年年初，他成了西灣河的電影資料館常客，一有空就往館內的資源中心觀看波叔電影錄像。那裏有約二十齣，他全都看了。

## 姑媽文蘭再登場

今年八月將有五套波叔作品重映，簡直是滴漏再滴漏的精華。「《紫釵記》係戲曲片，佢仲一人分飾兩角，一定係首選；《光棍姻緣》『擔番口大雪茄』，嗰陣幾乎全球華人都識唱，唔係誇張，都一定要揀。」呆佬及烏龍王兩個喜劇角色都是經典，當然也在名單上。「睇佢嘅喜劇，會覺得佢唔鍾意複製自己，成日有新演繹方式。佢嗰陣睇好多西片，吸收之後融匯貫通，令粵語片無咁悶。」波叔歡樂傳萬家，總是讓觀眾笑到腹肌結實。

選播《嬌嬌女》，意義重大。電影女主角正是波叔女兒文蘭，是父女檔合演作品。「我哋希望有演員可以出席首映，姑媽可以。佢拍嗰陣十八歲，今年倒轉佢八十歲，好得意。」說到這齣作品，他雙眼發光，聲線激昂，表達對粵語片刮目相看之情。「姑媽嗰陣成個『港版柯德莉夏萍』咁，好靚，成套戲根本係《West Side Story》。」他提及有一幕講述文蘭被古惑仔糾纏，接下去的劇情震懾他每個細胞。「撩女仔我諗住都係摸下手仔呀咁，點知竟然係跳踢躑舞，仲要跳得好靚，好《La La Land》。1956 年已經有呢種手法嘅電影，仲要拍得好睇。粵語片一啲都唔殘，型㗎原來！」唔睇唔知咁好睇！昔日港產片走得前，只是年輕一代認定粵語片娘夾悶，見到都立即轉台而後快。



以前要他相信有些事冥冥中有主宰，不可能，但他現在覺得有些事真的「整定」。「以前唔信，但『我們的波叔』呢個活動真係無心插柳。舊年年底 UA CineHub 負責人 Ivan 打電話畀我，話不如播番爺爺啲戲，然後我又識咗電影資料館嘅人，發現原來佢哋一早計劃今年搞『雄·雙·喜』喜劇拍檔 program，重映爺爺同劉恩甲合演嘅『南北三部曲』。爺爺今年 110，姑媽 80，我 40，年齡都係齊頭，好似注定呢件事要今年發生咁。」

## Sir 波不離地

梁醒波三個字響噹噹，他當然「細細個就聽過呢個名」。可是相處印象其實真係零。波叔 1981 年離世，他當時只是個三歲人仔，最記得竟是瞻仰波叔遺容那個畫面。「我腦海一直有阿媽抱住我去睇呢個畫面，大個先知咩事。」波叔離去，不只是梁家痛失親人，那時整個香港都哀悼。Andrew 憶起許冠文兒子許思維曾跟他說：「你知唔知波叔當年死係幾大件事？《歡樂今宵》都要停播。」

追尋爺爺的事蹟，除了演藝成就，他更欣賞他的做人態度。「佢好貼地，你諗下佢係首位華人演藝家得到英女皇頒授 M.B.E. 勳銜，佢係 Sir 呀，但平日開棚戲，喺棚後面佢一樣著住背心短褲同大家一齊食飯，無大明星架子。」

這位大明星更出心出力為接班人謀福祉。幾十年前，很多粵劇子弟都目不識丁，波叔為了讓大家讀懂文本了解所唱的內容，積極爭取開辦八和子弟學校。每日早上八點他都站在教育司門前等候官員接見，最後成功爭取在舊樓天台辦學。「佢知道識字嘅重要，就算啲子弟最後唔做戲都可以唔使做苦工。佢一直善用身份幫人。我身為佢個孫，都要好好地做人。」

波叔是三棲藝人，粵劇、電影、電視各有粉絲。植根於粵劇舞台的他，沒因登上大銀幕或進了公仔箱就忘記粵劇本位，一直出力扶助。「佢好前瞻，見到粵劇後來少咗觀眾，又無乜新演員加入，佢見汪阿姐瓜子口面做花旦一定好靚，於是鼓勵汪阿姐學大戲。」波叔懂得運用明星的號召力，吸引非大戲迷觀眾。後來他又催生八和粵劇學院，有系統地培育新秀，提攜後進，而且常親自到校巡視，並非掛名出風頭，稱波叔為香港粵劇發展推手，不為過。

## 波叔玩 Facebook？

《梁醒波傳—亦慈亦俠亦詼諧》一書推出時，Andrew 特別為爺爺開了「梁醒波 Leung Sing Por, MBE」Facebook 專頁 (<https://www.facebook.com/LeungSingPorMBE/>)，一直打理至今。「都有接近九年時間啦！借呢個平台不定期講下波叔，畀影迷睇番啲點滴，分享下佢以前嘅生活照。」帖文還包括粵劇新秀演出資料、粵語知識、波叔昔日廣告共賞、甚至 Joan Cornella 展覽介紹等等。「梁醒波」馳騁虛擬世界玩面書，有趣！

波叔把孫兒帶到自己輝煌的年華，孫兒把波叔帶到高科技的當下，兩爺孫，似遠還近。

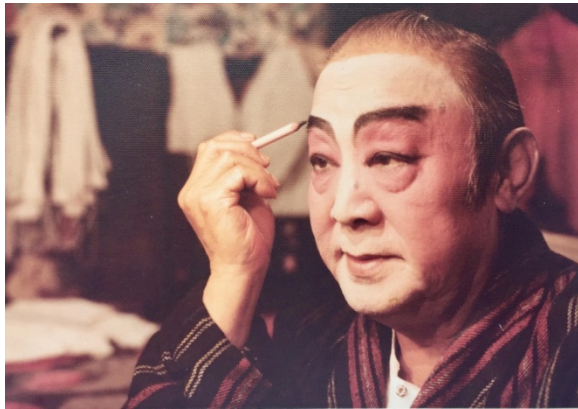

香港的朋友，不要錯過喔！

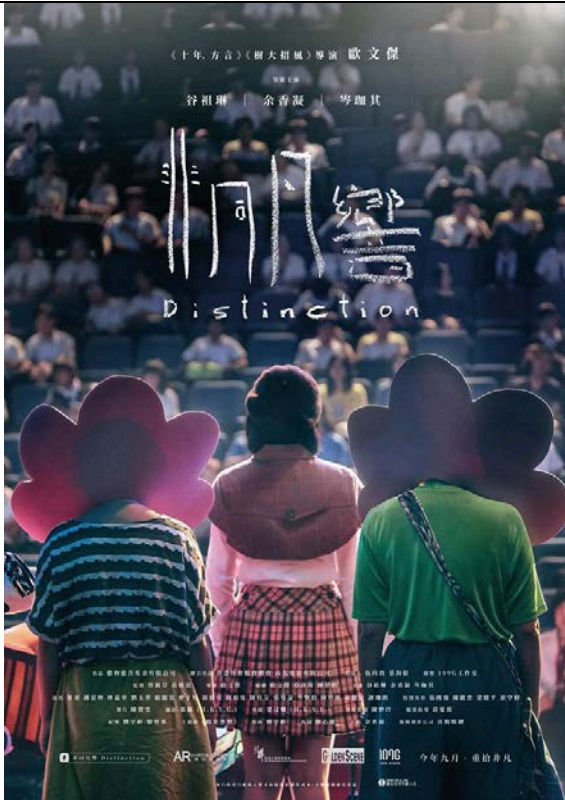






## 電影簡介：
