

It was April in Portugal, not Paris, when La Salle old boys in NY/East Coast chapter got together for their Portuguese themed spring dinner on April 20, 2019 at Dan and Tania Souza's home in Connecticut.

Everyone was thrilled to have three generations represented as seniors mingled with millennial LaSallians like Jeff Ng and Philip Lo. Philip and Été brought along their son, Byron, the cutest 2 year old you will ever meet, who was the star of the show, representing the third generation.

An array of Portuguese dishes made for a memorable menu. The highlight was a whole suckling pig, seasoned with herbs and roasted to perfection, eliminating almost all fat, to the delight of the health-conscious old boys and their families. "Hey, there's no fat on this pig!" remarked Virginia Ng approvingly, always the observant gourmet. Our French Culinary Institute trained LaSallian Bel Baptista did the honors carving the pig like a surgeon, then amazingly reassembling the cut pieces to make up the pig again a trick only a LaSallian chef can perform.



The bolo de bacalhau (pronounced baka-lee-au) made of mash potato embedded with cod fish and baked, were a hit. They were served hot straight out of the oven making them even more tasty.

The grilled sardines, a staple of any Portuguese meal, were also received enthusiastically by all. It was a miracle no one choked on any of the fine bones as almost 3 dozen fish were devoured in record time.

The main dish was "arroz marisco" a.k.a. "葡國海鮮飯" or Portuguese seafood rice, bringing together shrimp, scallop, little neck clams etc. cooked in arborio rice. Other goodies included a dessert of fresh raspberry-topped flan (ok that's a Spanish dish, but close enough to Portuguese) that everyone enjoyed.

In the beverage department, LaSallians stayed away from the beer and wine and went straight for the single malt whiskey generously supplied by Victor Lee, Simon Wai and others. As everyone knows, social drinking, but never to excess, is yet another talent of many LaSallians, especially when it comes to fine whiskey. Especially interesting was the 12 year old Balvenie Doublewood, so called for the technique of aging first in whiskey oak barrels then finished with additional time in sherry oak to give it a distinctive flavor only the Scottish distillers know how to produce.









On a serious note, committee members of LSCOBA NY/East Chapter who were present took advantage of the occasion to hold a mini-meet and plan for this year's Old Boys' events which will include: a trip to Toronto, Dragon Boat races, Hong Kong schools' alliance networking and a Fall get-together among others.

Overall, an enjoyable time was had by all. Once again, LaSallians continued our age-old tradition of getting together to enjoy each others' company, have some laughs, break bread and have a good time. It was a blast!


